



Funding for excellent life scientists

EMBO supports life scientists around the world at all career stages, with programmes that stimulate the exchange of knowledge and help to build an environment in which scientific research can thrive.

Life scientists from Chile are eligible to apply to the following programmes:

EMBO Global Investigator Network

Funding, networking and training opportunities for group leaders in the early stages of setting up their own independent laboratories

EMBO Postdoctoral Fellowships

Contract-based funding opportunities for postdoctoral researchers for up to two years fostering their international mobility

EMBO Short-Term Fellowships

Funding to support international research exchanges of up to three months between laboratories

EMBO Courses and Workshops

Funding for organizers of about 90 scientific meetings per year that attract more than 11,000 participants

EMBO Core Facility Fellowships

Funding for training exchanges of up to one month between core research facilities to learn specific techniques and acquire expertise
